    - v) Play reasonably swiftly so as not to hold up play for everyone else. That means around 7 to a maximum of 7:30 minutes per hand.
  - b) It was agreed we have Summer and Xmas events.
  - c) If anyone wants to assist in scoring or TD work, speak with a committee member.
  - d) The pot washing and clearing up is working well when we have a half table. It's not so good when we don't; the same members are doing most of it. A few options for changes were discussed. However, AB advised that we have been talking to the Hall committee about having a dish washer installed and they are enthusiastic. We shan't make any changes until their deliberations are completed.
